Some useful features of these news services:

- All posts are **searchable**
- All posts are **archived**
- Posts can be **viewed by subject** area, eg: care practice, drug therapy, late stage dementia, research
- You can **add a comment**
- You can **set up a feed** (ATOM or RSS) to the post, which means that you can quickly see what has recently been added.
- You can also set up feed with TalkR which will allow you to **listen to the feed**.
- You can also set up a request to sent you **notification via email** of new posts.

To set up email alerts

1. Open the news service <http://alznews.blogspot.com/> and <http://alzheimersnswlibrary.blogspot.com/> (or use the alternative web addresses indicated above)
2. On the right hand menu bar there is a box titled "Email Notification"
3. Enter your email address in the box, and then click Subscribe.
4. An "email subscription request" box will open up in a new window.
5. You will then need to type the letters that appear on the screen into a box. This is to decrease spam.
6. After you have typed the letters, click the "complete subscription" request button. (If you type the letters incorrectly a new request will appear. Repeat step 5 and 6)
7. A new screen will appear which indicates that your request has been received. Click "close window" words at bottom of this box.
8. Complete step 2 to 7 for each new email address you wish to register.
9. **You should immediately receive email verification** of your subscription. Once you receive email verification from "confirmations@emailenfuego.com" the service address that delivers email subscriptions, **you will need to click a link listed in this message to activate your subscription**. *Note: Occasionally email verification can take up to 24 hours, however if you have not received an email within 24 hours, please check your spam and junk email box as it may have automatically been diverted there. If your emails are going into spam and junk, your email alerts will also be diverted there. For junk email you can right click on the email and select from the menu "add to safe sender list"; for spam please refer to your IT department or your spam software manual.*

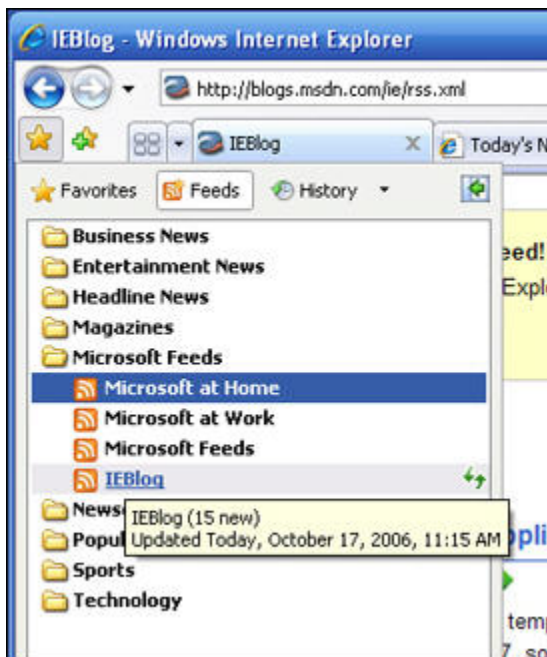
Remember you can still view all news by visiting the websites.

To set up a feed

1. Open the news service <http://alznews.blogspot.com/> and <http://alzheimersnswlibrary.blogspot.com/>
2. Click the **"Subscribe to news feed"**, which is located on the right hand side of the news site. 
 - To receive a news feed which talks to you click **"subscribe to audio feed"** located on the right hand side of the news site. 
3. A new page will open which will have the title of the news service in a yellow box.
4. In the yellow box locate "Subscribe to this Feed" 
5. Click on **"Subscribe to This Feed"**

To view your feeds in Internet Explorer 7

1. Click on Favorites Group Icon.
2. Then click on Feeds icon.
3. Select the feed you wish to view.
